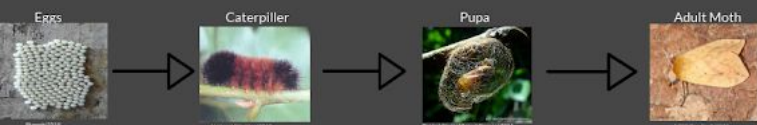


Isabella Tiger Moth

Habitat

- The Isabella Tiger Moths habitat varies with life stages. As a small caterpillar, the "Woolly Bear" stays on its leaf.
- As a caterpillar, the Woolly Bear scales trees and plants in forests.
- Once the Adult Woolly Bear has completed the eating phase it will turn into an adult moth. The Adult moth goes and lives on it's live in prairies and forest of North America and sometimes even abandoned agricultural fields.

Reproduction and Mating

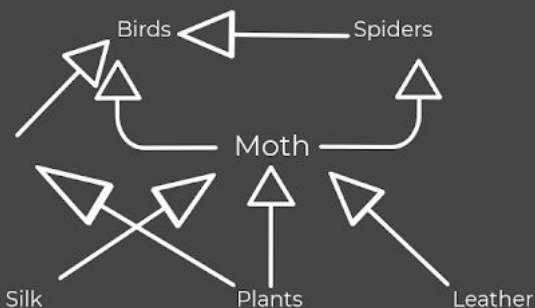
The Moth mating process is a fast and simple reproduction method...
