

Red-Winged Blackbird

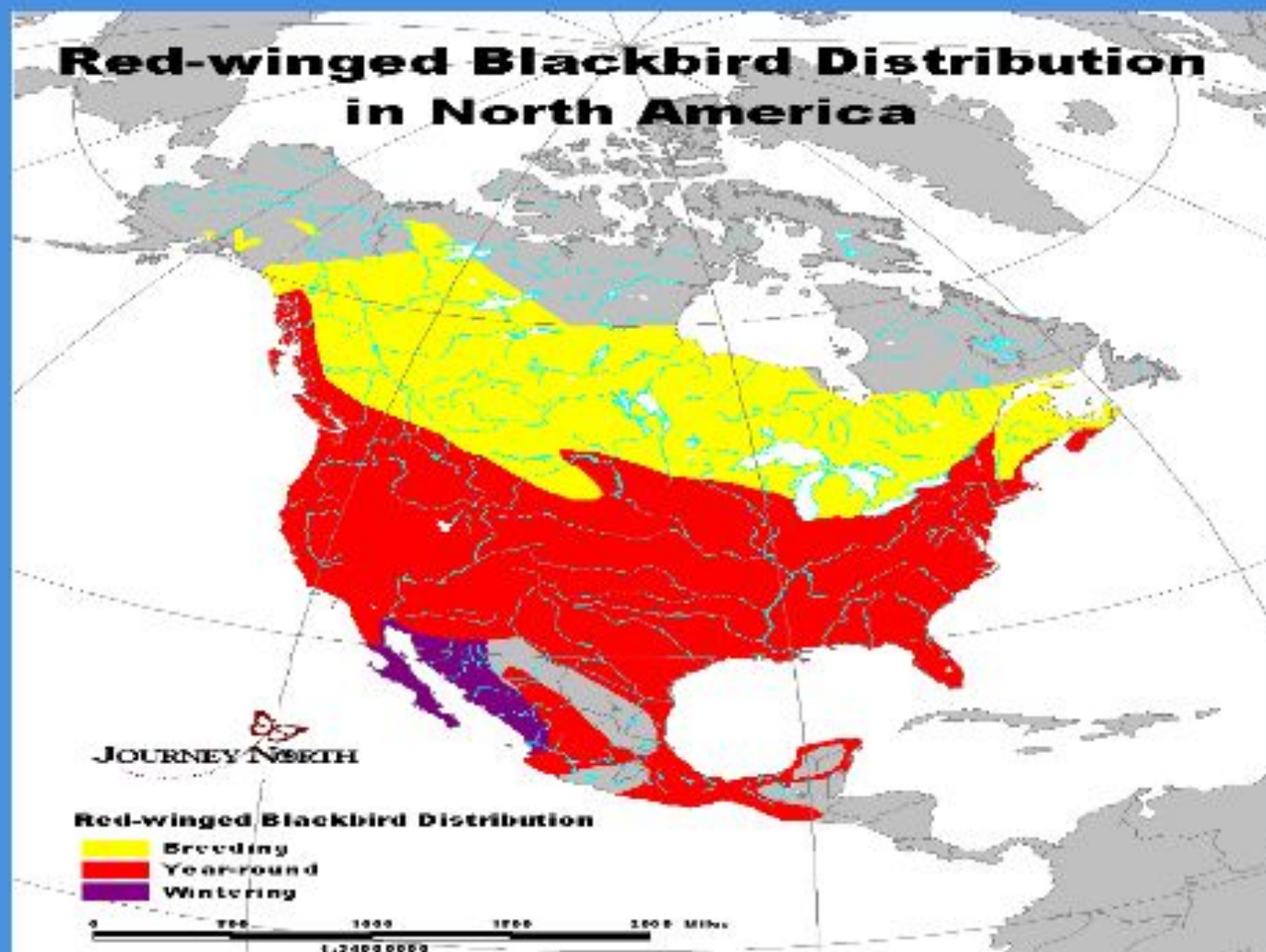


Description: The Red-Winged Blackbirds is a unique type of blackbird because of its red epaulets with a strip of yellow at the bottom of the epaulets.

Reproduction: Red-Winged Blackbirds are polygamous which means 1 male with many females.

Fun Facts:

- The Red-Winged Blackbird travels 800 miles south for the winter
- Its wingspan is 24.0 centimeters long
- Red-Winged Blackbirds leave the nest 11 to 14 days after hatching
- Its scientific name is *Agelaius phoeniceus*
- It weighs around 1.4 to 2 ounces
- Males have red shoulder epaulets while females do not.
